A. 3- Chair concept

In renovating Ghent ICC the architects took their inspiration from the three-seat concept. This makes Ghent ICC unique in Belgium, since it has one seat for every guest in:

- The main congress hall
 - This large hall for plenary sessions has 944 comfortable seats
- The break-out rooms/meeting rooms
 - There are 11 break-out rooms, for groups of 10 to 400 people (total capacity 1.500 persons), some of them with daylight
- The banquet room
 - The banquet room seats up to 1.000 people, with excellent catering facilities.

B. Catering rooms

Ghent ICC has several catering rooms at its disposal on every floor:

 - o Artevelde Forum: 1600 m²
 - o Pedro De Gante Hall: 1600 m²
 - Casino Room: 1226 m² (2 fixed bars)

B. To Ghent

- By air: Brussels Airport (Zaventem)
 - +/- 140 international and regional carriers serve Belgium
 International Airport, from more than 70 international cities.
 Ghent can easily be reached from the airport:
 - By train: direct connection, every half hour, journey time 53 min.
 - By car: a +/- 45 minutes driving

Other Belgian airports (Ostend, Antwerp, Charleroi, Liège) are served by regional carriers and also have easy connections to Ghent.

- By train:
 - o Thalys:
 - Gent has a direct connection with Paris (+/- 2.25h)
 (no stopovers)
 - Ghent can easily be reached from all major European cities via Brussels Midi Station
 - Eurostar:
 - Via Brussels Midi Station: London is only 3,5 hours away from Ghent
- By car:
 - Ghent is ideally located at the intersection of the E-17 and E-40 motorways, which guarantees an easy access from the whole of Europe.



C. In Ghent

A part of the city centre is **pedestrian area**: an area of some 35 hectares – 86 acres. A parking route, or P-route, has been introduced to pick up the traffic towards the city centre on the ring road and take it to a car park in the immediate proximity of the P-route, thus making Ghent both accessible and pleasant to live in. Most hotels offer a private car park.

Gent ICC is within 15 minutes walking distance from the historical heart of Ghent and from most of the hotels. Numerous local car companies can offer a shuttle service for the congress participants. Also "De Lijn" – the public transport service – can provide extra buses.

For the hotels located just outside the city centre (if you are willing to count them in), there could be either an **own shuttle service** from the hotel or the provided congress shuttles.

With the parking app you can see in which parking lot you can go.

You can easily download the data from the Ghent traffic guidance system on your smartphone. Both iOS users (iPad, iPhone) and Android users (Samsung, HTC, ...) can watch live utilization of urban parks. The parking app leads you directly to through the GPS.

The Ghent city currently has **nine underground car parks**. Together they offer over 5000 parking places. The Ghent traffic guidance system put drivers on the right road through a network of dynamic LED signs. The signs lead the cars via the ring road (R40) to the car parks with available parking.













A. Bed & Breakfast

There are several Bed & Breakfasts in Ghent, accommodating you with the local people. Most of time the hosts are most willing to make acquaintance, which can be interesting in order to get to know the "real" Ghent citizens.
